

GUIDELINES FOR USE OF THE SPINNAKER RIDGE POOL:

Safety is always first.

We attempt to maintain water temperature at approximately 86-87degrees.

The pool is cleaned and treated twice per week by Aqua Care.

Monitoring the temperature, spring clean-up and fall closure by pool users is a volunteer activity in which everyone is invited to participate.

Pool users are asked to keep the pool area clean.

Put toys and chair cushions in the spa room, put down umbrellas, if you are last to leave lock gates.

PLEASE...

- **Read and follow PIERCE COUNTY POOL RULES.**
- **Enter the pool area only through the pool gates.**
- **Sign in, shower and sign out when leaving.**
- **Limit the number of guests you bring so that the pool can be shared by all who wish to use it.**
- **Be considerate of our neighbors living around the pool by keeping noise to a reasonable level.**
- **No glass containers are allowed in the pool or pool area.**
- **All swimmers age 17 and younger must be accompanied by an adult.**
- **ALL guests must be accompanied by resident.**
- **Pack it in, pack it out. Pool users are responsible for their own clean up, i.e. table tops, garbage, waste, diapers, food, etc.**
- **Return lounge pads and pool toys to spa room after use, put down your umbrella, turn off lights in the shower room and secure the locked gates. We do not have cleaning services for the pool area.**
