Pierce County//SRCA HOA Pool Rules

Pool capacity: 20

- *This is **NOT** a public pool. Only SRCA residents and their invited guests are permitted.
- *Residents must accompany and remain with guest(s).
- *All swimmers 17 years and younger must be accompanied by a resident adult.
- *There is **NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY**. Each person using the pool does so at their own risk.
- *When pool is officially open, pool hours are from 9:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m.
- *Only enter the pool through the two pool gates, not through the clubhouse. A key is required.
- *Always sign in and out on the sheet to the left of the door in the spa room.
- *All swimmers must shower before entering pool.
- *Shouting, running, diving and rough play are prohibited.
- *Large flotation devices are prohibited in the pool or pool area.
- *NO GLASS CONTAINERS are allowed in the pool area.
- *Use by anyone with a communicable disease is prohibited.
- *Use by anyone who has been ill with vomiting or diarrhea within the last two weeks is prohibited.
- *Use of the pool by anyone under the influence of alcohol or drugs is prohibited.
- *Any resident or guest with seizure, heart or circulatory problems should not swim without a buddy
- *SWIM DIAPERS are required for all children not potty trained. Diapers must have a tight fitting covering. A diaper changing station is available in each restroom. Soiled diapers must be taken away when you leave. Do NOT dispose of soiled diapers in the clubhouse or pool area trash cans.
- *There is a **RED PHONE** in the spa room for emergencies. Dial 911. Clubhouse address (6799 Erickson St.) is posted above red phone.
- *FIRST AID BOX is on wall to left of door in spa room.

*WHEN YOU LEAVE:

*Cleanup, sign out, turn out all lights, lower umbrellas, replace chairs (4 per table), return pool toys to spa room, & **BE SURE BOTH GATES ARE LOCKED.**

Persons who refuse to follow these rules are subject to removal from the premises.
